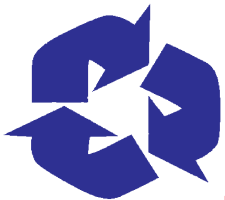

GOALS:

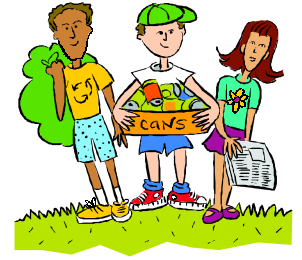
- *To promote education and awareness of environmental concerns leading to positive actions.*

- Curbside Recycling Program -

ACCEPTS: **Aluminium** Food or Beverage Cans; **Beverage containers** (milk cartons, juice boxes, etc.); **Boxboard** (non-corrugated); **Cardboard** (corrugated); **Catalogues**; **Flyers**; **Magazines**; **Newspapers**; **Glass Bottles and Jars** (Not Broken); **Steel Food or Beverage Cans**; **Plastics** (PET or PETE - Type 1 - Non-hazardous waste containers only), **Plastics** (HDPE-Type 2 - Non-hazardous waste containers only).

Place these items in a blue recycling bag at the curb on your garbage day pick up.

Teulon Elementary School is continuing to collect **Campbell Soup Labels** along with other labels as follows: V8 Beverages, Prego Spagetti Sauce, Chunky Soup & Chili, Pace Salsa, Ramen Noodles, Goldfish Crackers, Habitant Soups, Soup at Hand, Healthy Request Soup, Gardennay Soups, Chunky to Go Bowls, Broths. For the Fish Crackers and Broths, only the UPC label is required. Other products require the UPC and front label. Labels can be dropped off at the School or deposited into the barrel at Bigway Foods in Teulon.
